

## School Fees

The following rates apply to the academic year 2008/2009. While the School makes every effort to keep fee rises to a minimum from year to year, there usually has to be a small rise each year to cover rising costs and inflation.

### INFANT SCHOOL (5 – 7 years old)

Day Pupils\* £1825 per term

### JUNIOR SCHOOL (8 – 10 years old)

Day Pupils\* £2725 per term

Weekly Boarding £4900 per term

Full Boarding £5600 per term

### MIDDLE SCHOOL (11 – 13 years old)

Day Pupils\* £3000 per term

Weekly Boarding £5225 per term

Full Boarding £5875 per term

### SENIOR SCHOOL (14 – 16 years old)

Day Pupils\* £3325 per term

Weekly Boarding £5650 per term

Full Boarding £6350 per term

### SIXTH FORM-IB YEARS (17 – 18 years old)

(Fees held for both 6th Form years)

Day Pupils\* £3800 per term

Weekly Boarding £6100 per term

Full Boarding £6800 per term

(The termly fees for IB students are held at this rate for the duration of the two-year course.)

\*In addition a termly charge of £160 is made for lunch.

### INTENSIVE ENGLISH SECTION

Normal fees above plus £1100 per term

### EXTRA SUBJECTS – FEES

Fees for extra subjects are payable in advance and half a term's notice is required when lessons are to cease.

### OVERSEAS STUDENTS

Bank charges must be paid in the country of origin so that the full amount invoiced is received into our Bank account.

### PAYMENTS AND BURSARIES

There is a 10% sibling bursary in the boarding and tuition fees for second and subsequent children who are at School together. A full term's notice must be given or a full term's fees in lieu of notice must be paid for a pupil leaving the School. Fees are payable in full on or before the first day of each term. There is a services bursary of 10% and a clergy bursary of 50%. All bursaries and remissions are subject to an annual review by Governors and are dependent upon the satisfactory behaviour and academic achievement of the pupil and the fee account for the pupil being paid prior to the commencement of each term.
